

The Credentialing Committee has decided to postpone the CPD Exam. The original exam dates were March 30 – April 5, 2020. ASPE is holding an online exam which means that candidates will not go to a test center to take their exams. Candidates will take the exam from the comfort of home or desired location that has a stable internet connection. The 2020 CPD Exam dates are June 15 – 28, 2020.

For candidates that previously scheduled their examination via PearsonVUE and paid the fee, your examination will be canceled and you will be issued a refund.

Pam Rosenberg will be sending out revisions and directions on the next steps.

On or around June 1, 2020, eligible candidates will receive updated instructions on how to begin registration and submit exam fees.
